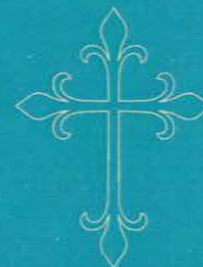

Richard McHenry and his wife Mary. It was incorporated May 2, 1957, and they opened the doors of its first cottage in 1961. Today Joy Ranch has five cottages on 62 acres and has helped provide a caring home for over 5,000 children since its inception.

The mission of Joy Ranch is to provide a welcoming, safe, caring, and Christ-centered environment to meet the spiritual, physical, emotional, and social needs of children and their families in crisis.
